Abaca suckers must be 3-4 months old. Stalk height should be between 0.6 meter to 1.0 meter. Leaves must not be cut off from the stalk to allow identification of possible symptoms of viral diseases. <p>Terms and Conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The winning bidder should submit authenticated Plant Nursery Operator Certificate of Accreditation. The winning bidder must have an identified source/s of planting materials such as existing abaca farms, nurseries, and laboratories that are free from diseases especially abaca mosaic, bract mosaic and bunchy-top duly certified by PhilFIDA and BPI Plant Quarantine. All planting materials should be free from visible diseases duly certified by the Plant Quarantine Officer from point of origin. The suckers will be delivered to the target barangays and the schedule of delivery sites will be enclosed in the Bidding Documents. Abaca suckers shall be delivered within a period of 60 calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed. The winning bidder shall provide mortality allowance of 2% of the number of suckers purchased. Partial payment shall be made every after delivery of 200,000 abaca suckers plus 2% mortality allowance to the barangays and after inspection and acceptance by PhilFIDA. The winning bidder shall notify the PhilFIDA Office five (5) days prior to their schedule of delivery. Full payment shall be made after complete delivery of 850,240 abaca suckers plus 2% mortality allowance, inspected and accepted by PhilFIDA. 		P15.00	P12,753,600.00
