SUBJECT : NO PERMIT TO TRANSPORT FIBER, NO UNLOADING POLICY

Administrative Circular No. 12 series of 2020, Chapter IV, Section 1 states:

Permit to Transport Fibers Within the Philippine Territory - No person shall ship or transport fiber, whether baled or loose, from one province to another within the Philippines unless a Permit to Transport Fibers (PTF) covering such fiber is issued by the Regional Director or his authorized representative having jurisdiction of the place of origin of the fiber to shipped.

The application for such a permit shall specify the (1) shipper, (2) kind of fiber, (3) grade, (4) volume, (5) province of origin, (6) name and address of the consignee, and (7) carrier.

A PTF shall be issued for a single shipment to one consignee. It is automatically canceled five (5) days after the date of issuance if the shipment was not undertaken.

All fibers transported must be acknowledged at the destination on the PTF accompanying such shipment by the consignee and attested by the assigned Inspector.

With the abovementioned provision, all officials and employees tasked to enforce the Administrative Circular No. 12 series of 2020 and other issuances related thereto, are hereby enjoined to implement **"No Permit to Transport Fiber (PTF), No Unloading of Fibers Policy"**.

Except fibers produced from different places in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) in consideration of their current government set-up.

This Memorandum shall take effect immediately until revoke in writing.
