
## **Process Flow of Issuance of Licenses**

#### INTRODUCTION

This Service Guide is prepared by the PhilFIDA Regulatory Division for all person or entity engaged in the grading/baling, processing/manufacturing, classifying, buying and selling of Philippine commercial fibers.

This guide aims to provide basic and salient information on licensing to the above mentioned fiber participants, to enable them to comply with the requirements on the filing of applications for licenses provided in the PhilFIDA Administrative Circular No. 12 s. 2020.

Likewise, the prescribed streamlined procedures and timelines in the issuance of licenses to our stakeholders are provided herein.

## AS PER AC NO. 12 CHAPTER II SEC. 1. PERSON OR ENTITY ENGAGED IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES IS REQUIRED TO REGISTER AND SECURE A LICENSE FROM THE AUTHORITY:

- Grading and baling Philippine commercial fiber intended for domestic and export market;
- 2. Buying and selling commercial fibers for domestic market;
- 3. Buying approved bales for export;
- 4. Buying fibers for their mother companies;
- 5. Processing/manufacturing fibers with government prescribed standard;
- 6. Classifying Philippine commercial fibers.

#### 1. Grading Baling Establishments (GBE)

- 1.1 One (1) metric weighing device with certificate of periodic calibration;
- 1.2 At least one (1) baling press;
- 1.3 Minimum floor area of 850 sq. m. for classification work and storage;
- 1.4 Warehouse with segregating partition with other commodities; and
- 1.5 At least one (1) licensed classifier.

#### 2. Buying Station

- 2.1 Certification ownership by the mother company;
- 2.2 At least one (1) metric weighing device with certificate of periodic calibration.
- 2.3 Warehouse with segregating partition for other commodities;
- 2.4 A minimum floor area of 250 sq. m. for classification and storage; and
- 2.5 At least one (1) licensed classifier.

#### 3. Trader-Exporter

- 3.1 At least one (1) metric weighing device with certificate of periodic calibration; and
- 3.2 Warehouse with segregating partition from other commodities.

#### 4. Local Trader

#### Class A

- 4.1 One (1) metric weighing device with certificate of periodic calibration;
- 4.2 A minimum floor area of 250 sq. m. for classification and storage;

- 4.3 Warehouse with segregating partition from other commodities;
- 4.4 At least one (1) baling press or manual pressing device; and
- 4.5 At least one (1) licensed classifier.

#### Class B, C, D

- 4.6 At least one (1) metric weighing device with certificate of periodic calibration; and
- 4.7 Warehouse with segregating partition from other commodities.

#### 5. Processor

- 5.1 At least one (1) metric weighing device with certificate of periodic calibration;
- 5.2 Warehouse with segregating partition from other commodities;
- 5.3 At least one (1) licensed classifier (optional for Class C and D); and
- 5.4 Written description on how the fibers are to be utilized
